

Ballot Arguments for RAP Tax

On Tuesday, August 12, 2025, the City Council voted to place a RAP Tax on the 2025 Municipal November 4, 2025, Ballot. If approved by voters, the tax would be a 0.1% sales tax and the funds collected could only be spent on recreation facilities such as parks and trails.

The sales tax rate means \$0.01 would be collected for every \$10 spent.

The Ballot language will read as follows, "Shall Monroe City, Utah, be authorized to impose 0.1% sales and use tax to help fund recreational facilities in Monroe?"
